NORMAN THOMAS, PAPERS

BACKGROUND:

Norman Thomas was recruited in 1954, as a research associate, by the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company as a researcher for the company history: *Timber and Men*. At the time, he was a graduate student at the University of Minnesota. He graduated with a B. A. from Yankton College, received his Master's degree from the University of South Dakota, and his Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota. While working on the Weyerhaeuser Company history, he began to teach at the University of Puget Sound, and in 1957, he was hired by the University as an associate professor in the History department. While at the university, he held several positions; Dean of Faculty (1960) and Dean of the Graduate School (1965). In 1967, Thomas left the University of Puget Sound for Detroit Institute of Technology as Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. Aside from the University of Puget Sound and the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company, Thomas was a founding trustee of the Charles Wright Academy for boys located in Tacoma. SCOPE & CONTENT:

This collection contains Thomas' notes, research material, and draft manuscripts for the history of the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company, *Timber and Men*. The materials cover a wide range of subjects concerning the timber industry including: advertisements, articles, bibliographies, biographies, blueprints, broadcasts, bulletins, committee records, conferences, corporation information, correspondence, ephemera, genealogies, invitations, histories, legislation, maps, meetings, memoranda, memorials, newsletters, newspapers, notes, pamphlets, photographs, reports, statistics, union activities, West Coast Lumber Association records, and Weyerhaeuser branch operation information.

Thomas' notes provide a comprehensive investigation of the timber industry and the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company, from its purchases of forest land in 1900, in the Pacific Northwest, to the 1960s. Emphasis is placed on Weyerhaeuser's practices in Washington State. However, Thomas did research other facets of the company's operations, especially in Minnesota. Aside from the Weyerhaeuser Timber Co., Thomas' notes concentrate on the logging industry in the Pacific Northwest, biographies, railroad companies, and union activities. These notes were used in Thomas' manuscript drafts. Also found in this collection are Thomas' records of the founding of the Charles Wright Academy in Tacoma in 1959.
