Background:

The New England Society of Washington Territory was founded in Olympia, W.T., in 1869 to “keep alive the New England spirit, and by recalling the virtues, trials, and heroism of the past, to foster similar traits in the present and future generations, and to encourage the spirit of harmony and sociability....”

Scope and Content:

The volume contains the constitution and the names, city of residence, and state of origin of 79 individuals. The last three pages contain notes in the hand of Thomas Prather: p. 261 notes cash and land subscriptions to the “Northern Pacifick,” Port Townsend Southern, and Union Pacific Railroads; p. 262 notes land and work subscriptions to the Olympia & Tenino Rail Road; and p. 264 lists genealogical information about Thomas Prather’s family.
