BACKGROUND

The son of Swedish immigrants, George H. Boldt was born on December 28, 1903 in Chicago. After graduating from the University of Montana Law School in 1926, he migrated to Tacoma and formed a law partnership with A.E. Blair. Representing the State of Washington, Boldt worked as a special assistant attorney general in litigation involving the Tacoma Narrows Bridge collapse and in the acquisition of the Puget Sound ferry system. He served in World War II with the office of Strategic Services (OSS) in the Burma Campaign and in the China theater of the war.

In 1953, he was appointed U.S. District Court judge for Western Washington by President Dwight D. Eisenhower and became the district's chief judge in 1971. His judicial career included assignments with the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals in San Francisco, and as trial judge in many part of the United States including New York, Chicago, and Washington DC. Judge Boldt gained a reputation for clearing crushing case backlogs, not only from his Tacoma court but from those of many Eastern cities, without ever being reversed by an appellate court.

Judge Boldt presided over many controversial and complex cases, including the Dave Beck tax-evasion trial in Tacoma, the Mickey Cohen tax-evasion case in Los Angeles, and the "Seattle Seven" draft protest trial in Tacoma. However, the case he was most known for was the fight of Washington State Indians for their treaty fishing rights. In a landmark decision, handed down on February 12, 1974, Judge Boldt affirmed the right of Washington treaty Indians to an opportunity to take more than half of the harvestable fish in Western Washington. Later amended, but generally upheld by the U.S. Supreme Court, the decision forever changed the face of Washington's fishing industry.

Judge Boldt spent the next four years ironing out differences between the fishing industry and the treaty Indians. He retired from the bench in 1978. Aside from working the bench, Boldt also served as chairman of the federal Pay Board in President Nixon's economic

stabilization program from 1971 to 1973. He was married to Eloise and had three children. Judge Boldt died in 1984 due to complications of heart disease.
